Applicants must be Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander or the film must be themed around reconciliation.

Applications will be assessed and short-listed by the Nunga Screen Programmer along with a panel with representatives from Country Arts SA.

## BACKGROUND

Nunga Screen (formally known as Black Screen) promotes cultural awareness and Indigenous screen culture, providing entertainment to communities bringing them together in discussion. Country Arts SA supports the industry by showcasing Australia's Indigenous talent on and off screen.

The program connects culture, stories and language with community through screen and which celebrate South Australian Indigenous film and culture.

Nunga Screen is a short film showcase held annually on Reconciliation Week across South Australia hosted by suburban and regional venues. The screenings are a free community event.

The program is presented in South Australia by Country Arts SA and the 'Give up Smokes for Good' campaign from Drug and Alcohol Services of South Australia (DASSA), with support from the South Australian Film Corporation.

The objective of the program is to provide an opportunity for emerging and established Indigenous film makers to showcase their films across South Australia.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applicants must be of Aboriginal and or Torres Strait Islander descent or;
- The film must be themed around reconciliation
- Applicants must present a unique film that inspires challenges and entertains an increasingly broad and diverse audience

*Priority will be given to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander film makers.*

## APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE

- Artist contact details
- Film title, duration and rating
- One paragraph film synopsis
- Supporting documentation that may contribute to the promotion of the work
- Director's statement
- Biography of the director and producer
- A file share download link containing the film (alternatively a USB may be supplied)
- High resolution film stills

## CONDITIONS

By submitting the EOI and the above materials, the applicant(s) grant Country Arts SA a non-exclusive licence to publicly screen the selected film as part of Nunga Screen 2020 (May 27 – June 3, 2020) in South Australian regional and suburban venues.

Film files will be used for the sole purpose of considering the suitability of the film for the Nunga Screen program and will not be used for any other purpose without the permission of the rights holder.

Once a film has been selected to participate in Nunga Screen the film maker will be issued with an agreement of screening.

The film maker may not withdraw the film from the program once it has been selected for participation.

Country Arts SA may refuse to allow the participation of any film where the print or digital format of that film fails to meet the technical requirements for a public screening of good quality.

Please note that Nunga Screen is a FREE community screening across SA and does not act as a Festival or Competition. Therefore, it's screening should not inhibit your opportunity to enter film festivals. Please check with your producer and the film festival you are entering into regarding eligibility.
