We have gone cashless with contactless payments facilities for all ticket and refreshment purchases.




We have increased our cleaning protocols regularly disinfecting all high touch point areas in our venues.

New Arrangements




Our venue capacities have been reduced to adhere to social distancing requirements. We have installed signage at all venues so you know exactly how far away you need to be from other people.



When queuing in any area of the theatre we have added 1.5m distanced floor markings and other signage in our venues.



Performance and Movie session times will be staggered to limit the number of people in foyers and auditoriums at one time.



Entry and exit points within the venues will be clearly marked. Where possible, separate entry and exit points will be established.



Each individual space within in our venues has clear signage stating the capacity so that we adhere to current restriction requirements.



You will be required to provide your contact details as part of the ticket booking process.
